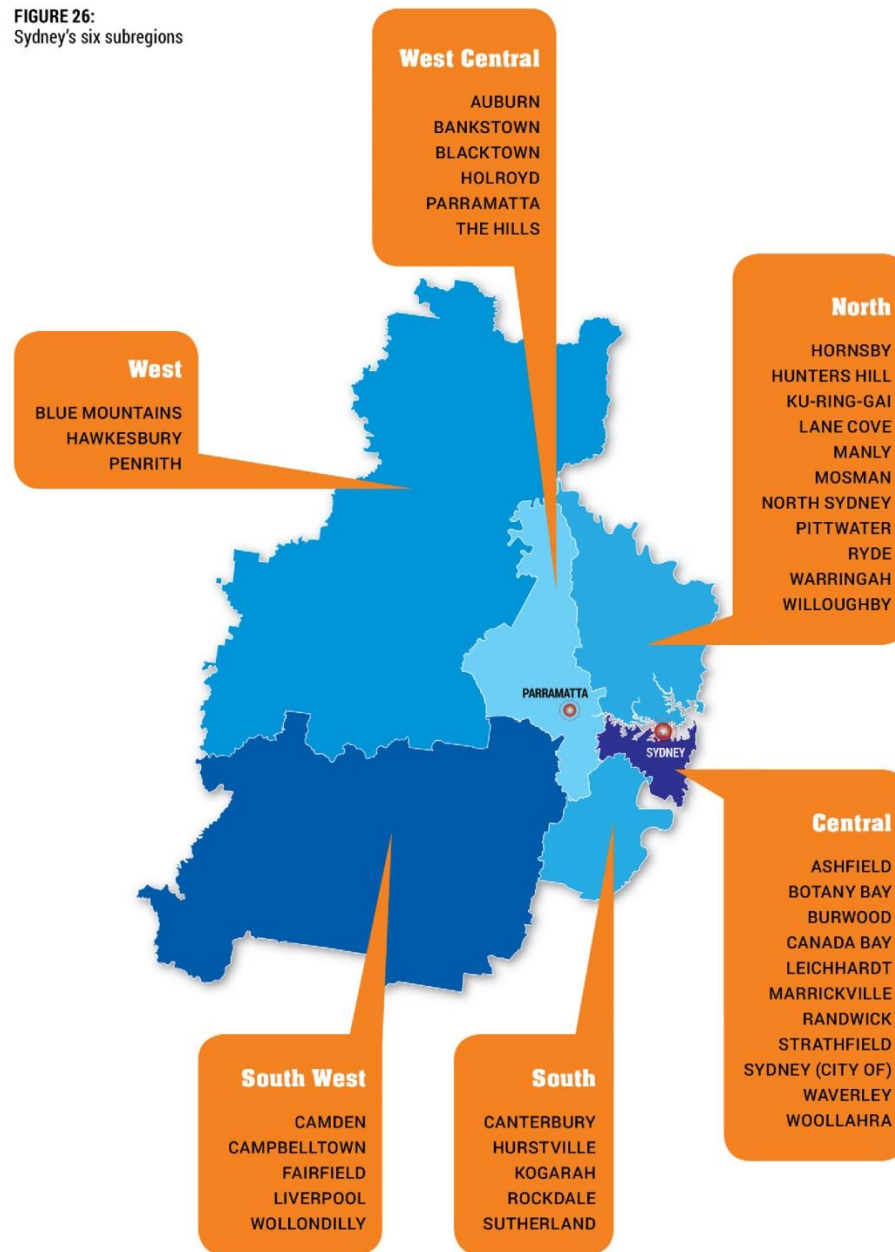


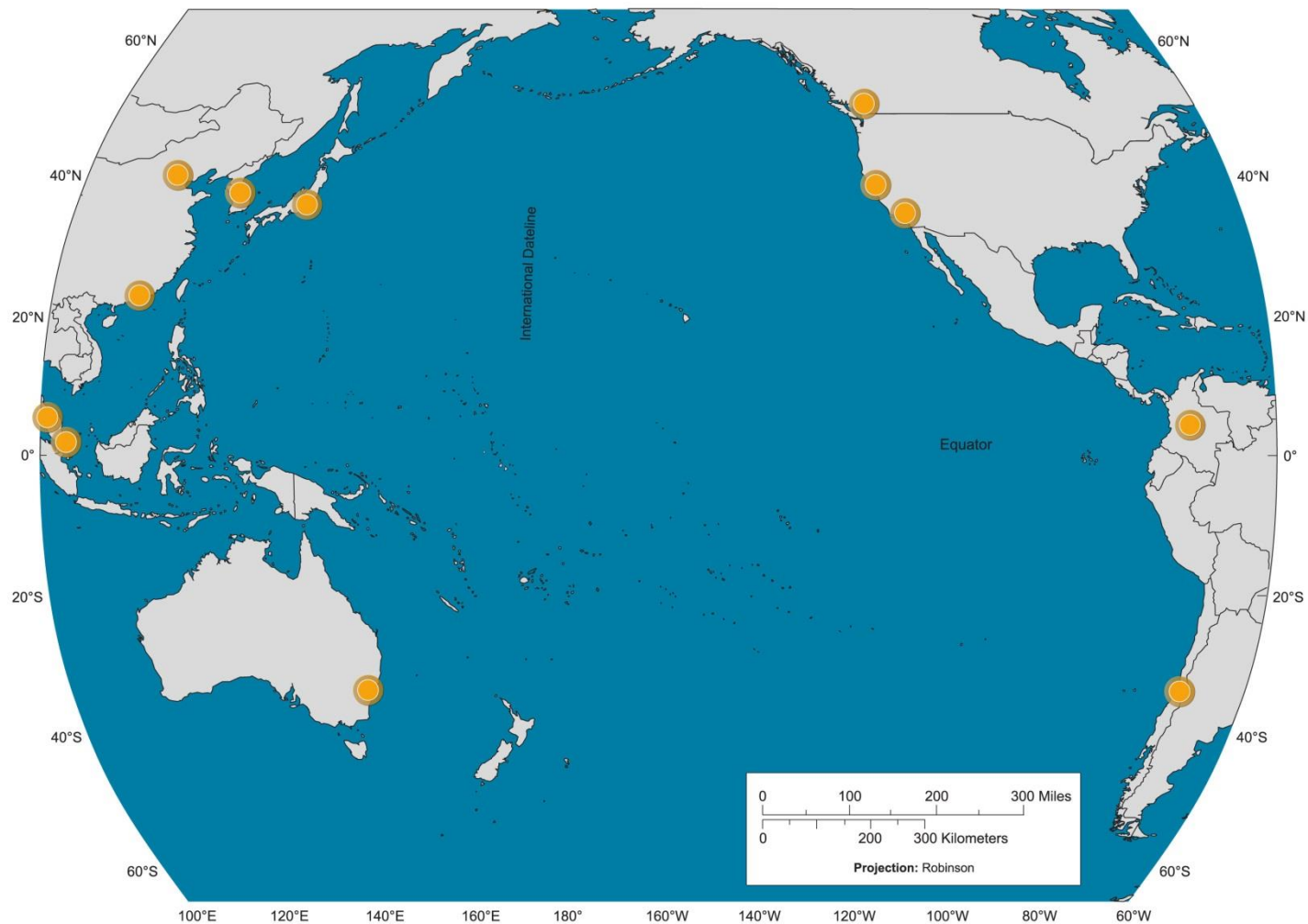

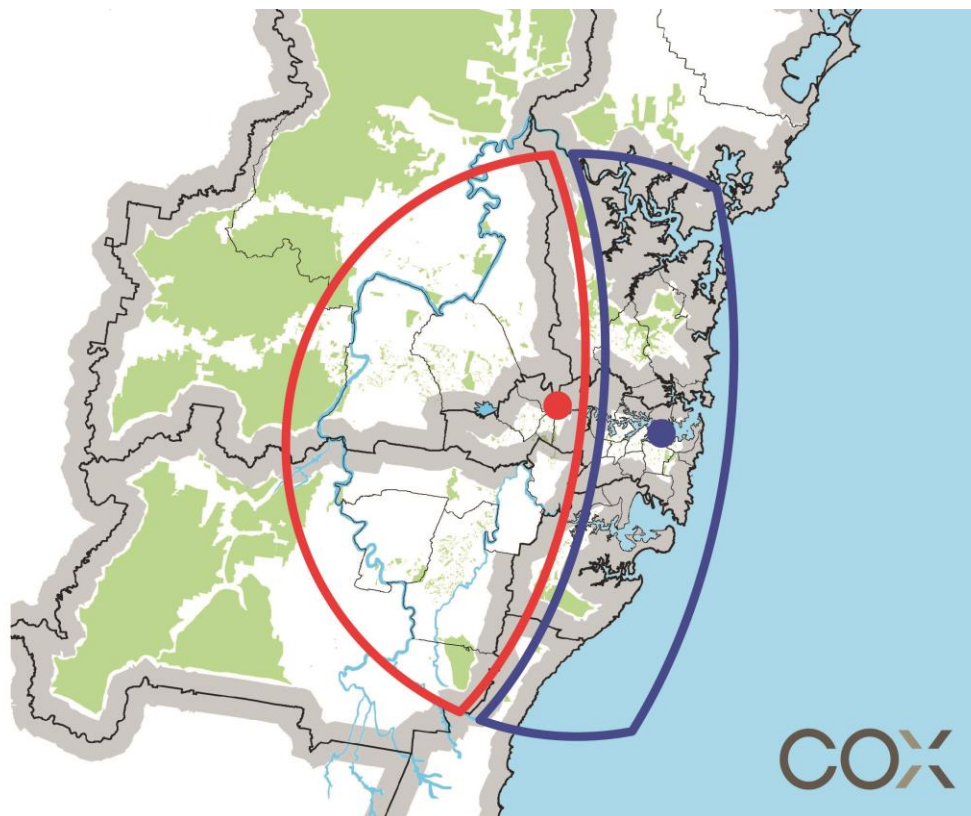

Sydney's six subregions

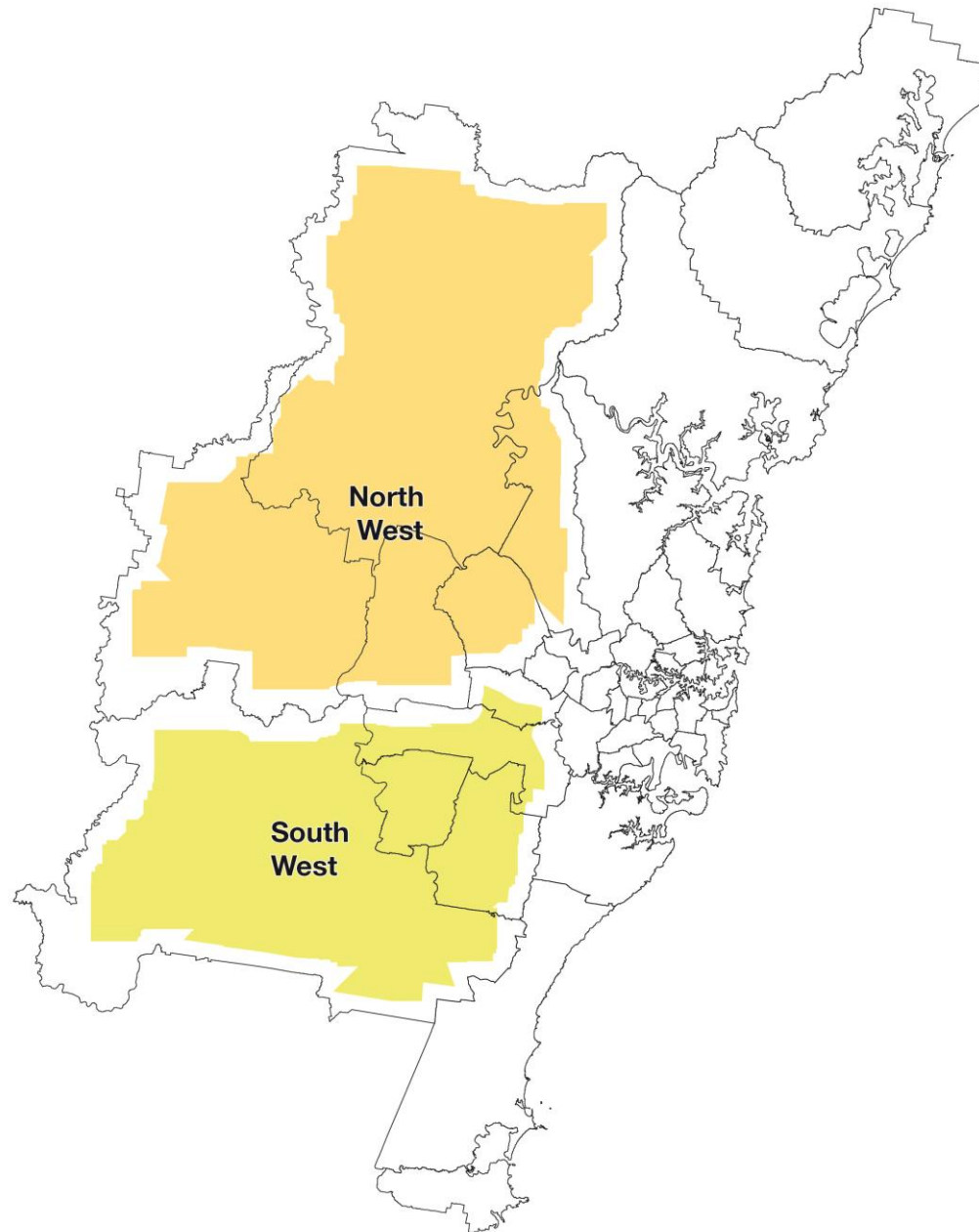


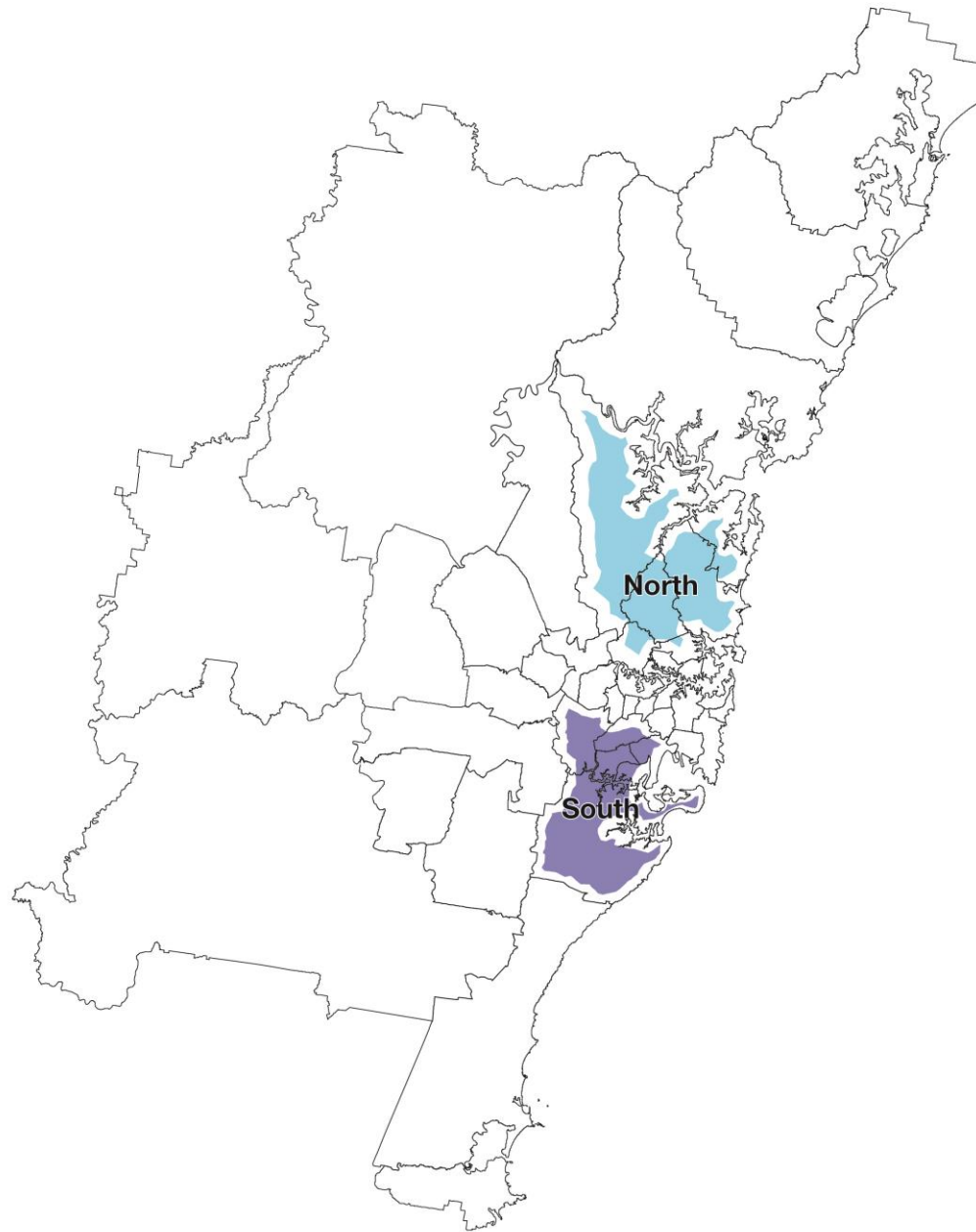




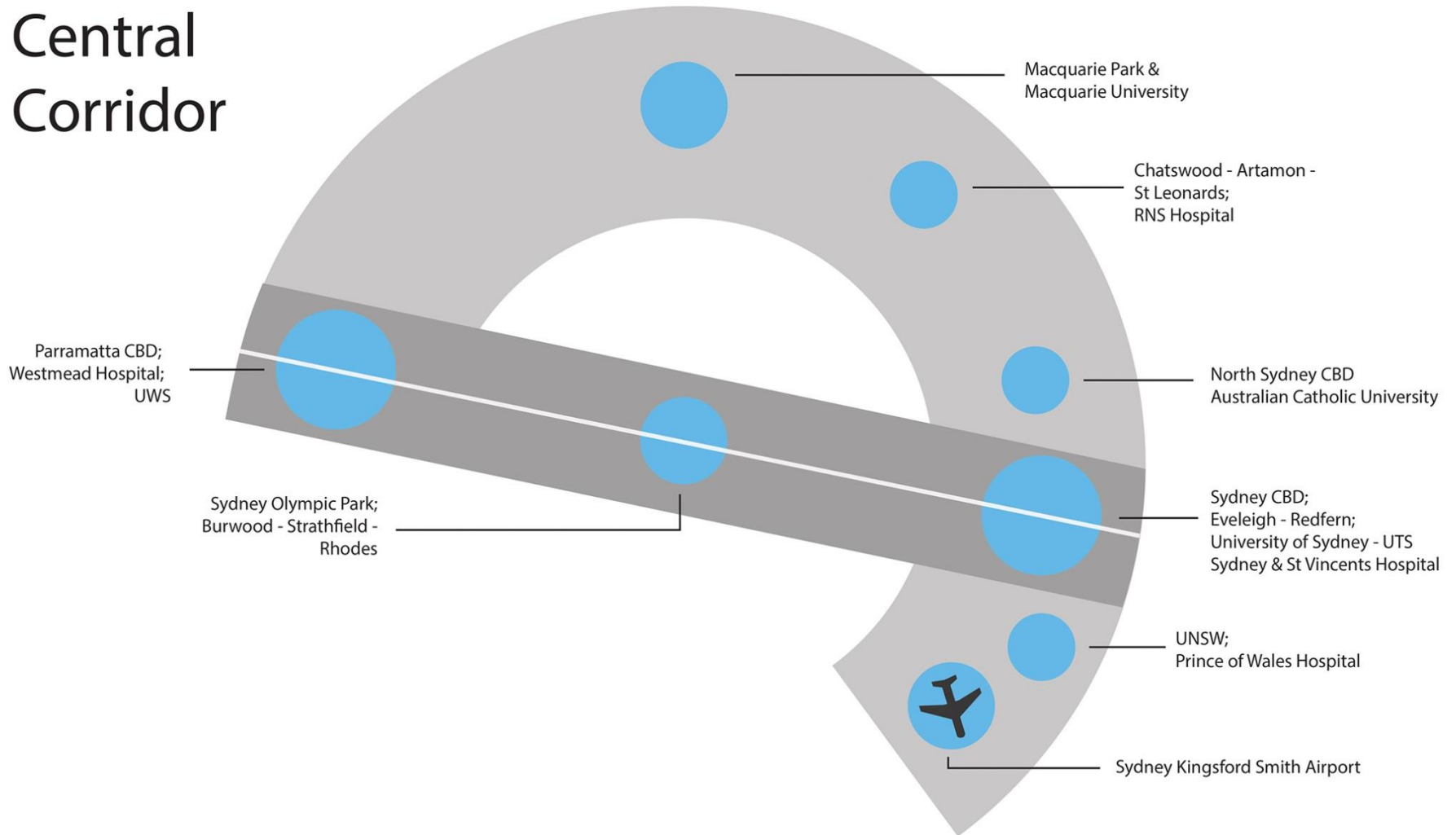
